Audition Preparation Course at The Old Sheriff Court

Led by Scottish Youth Theatre's Artistic Director, Mary McCluskey, this specialist course for **16-25 year olds** will focus on developing the techniques required for auditions. Particular focus will be spent on selecting appropriate monologues. Over the years, Mary McCluskey has worked with many young people who have successfully auditioned for Drama College. Many have gone on to have successful careers in the industry.

This course will run over two weekends; 12th Dec/13th Dec & 19th Dec/ 20th Dec. The course will run from 10am – 2pm each day at a cost of £160 for the four days or £40 per day

- Spaces can be **booked** by completing and signing the booking form and returning to Scottish Youth Theatre. All bookings are first come/ first served.
- All booking forms must be signed by parent or guardian (if participant is under 18 years of age). Forms can be accepted by post, fax, scanned and emailed or in person.
- Spaces can be **reserved** by telephone. However please note that a booking form along with payment is required as soon as possible to secure this place.
- **Payment** – classes can be paid either in full or in two equal installments (one on booking and one half way through the term). Fees can be accepted in cash, cheque or by credit/ debit card. If you wish to discuss other payment options please contact us on 0141 552 3988.
- **Family Discounts** – If there are two or more siblings attending classes please note that the first child pays in full and any additional siblings receive a 10% discount.
- **Cancellation** – It is at Scottish Youth Theatre's discretion if refunds are issued should you withdraw from classes.
