Audition Preparation Course at The Old Sheriff Court

Led by Scottish Youth Theatre's Artistic Director, Mary McCluskey, this specialist course for **16-25 year olds** will focus on developing the techniques required for auditions. Particular focus will be spent on selecting appropriate monologues. Over the years, Mary McCluskey has worked with many young people who have successfully auditioned for Drama College. Many have gone on to have successful careers in the industry.

This course will run over two weekends; 12th Dec/13th Dec & 19th Dec/ 20th Dec. The course will run from 10am – 2pm each day at a cost of £160 for the four days or £40 per day

- Spaces can be **booked** by completing and signing the booking form and returning to Scottish Youth Theatre. All bookings are first come/ first served.
- All booking forms must be signed by parent or guardian (if participant is under 18 years of age). Forms can be accepted by post, fax , scanned and emailed or in person.
- Spaces can be **reserved** by telephone. However please note that a booking form along with payment is required as soon as possible to secure this place.
- **Payment** – classes can be paid either in full or in two equal installments (one on booking and one half way through the term). Fees can be accepted in cash, cheque or by credit/ debit card. If you wish to discuss other payment options please contact us on 0141 552 3988.
- **Family Discounts** – If there are two or more siblings attending classes please note that the first child pays in full and any additional siblings receive a 10% discount.

- Classes are open to anyone aged between 3 and 25 years.
- Participants are taught by professional, experienced tutors with a passion for theatre and an expertise that is second to none.

3-4 year olds

Junior Skint Knees

Sat @ 11am – 12pm

Sun @ 12.30 – 1.30pm

Junior Skint Knees provides an introduction to drama through games, stories and art activities. Members are encouraged to develop their self expression and to explore their imaginations. All tutors are experienced in working with very young children and although some first timers can be overwhelmed by the lively atmosphere they soon settle in and realise that Junior Skint Knees is a lot of fun! The 3-4 class is one hour long.

5-7 year olds

Skint Knees continues the approach of JSK but the activities have more emphasis on improvisation, including movement, character and story. SYT 11-14 uses tutor led improvisation and drama games to help participants develop skills in acting such as character narrative development, voice and movement. Participant input is very important and much of each groups work will be inspired by issues of relevance to the participants. Most people find that SYT 11-14 is a great place to meet new friends with similar interests. Please note that this group will be split into 11-12's and 13-14's where possible. The 11-14 class runs for two hours.

SYT Senior Workshop

The Senior Workshop concentrates on improvisation and provides a wide ranging dramatic experience. It is open to anyone regardless of previous experience. The 15-25 class runs for two hours.
