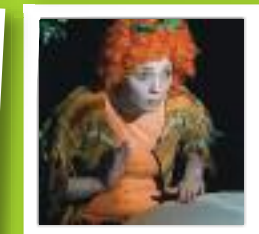
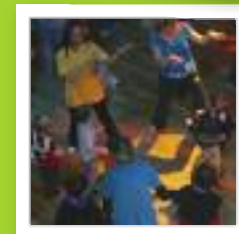
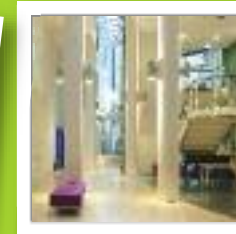

The SYT Productions team is also performing alongside participants from Y-Dance and the National Youth Pipe Band of Scotland on a new interpretation of Burns' **Tam O'Shanter** by Martin McCaig. This unique Homecoming production can be seen in the Great Hall at Stirling Castle and at Haddo House, Aberdeenshire in October.

As well as **The Puddock and the Princess**, the Brian Cox Studio will continue to be developed as the venue in Glasgow for family friendly events and performances. This autumn, some of Scotland's leading children's theatre companies will bring productions to the Brian Cox Studio in Glasgow's Merchant City. Scottish Youth Theatre will introduce storytelling sessions and DiscoTOTS for parents and toddlers.

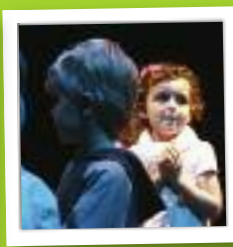

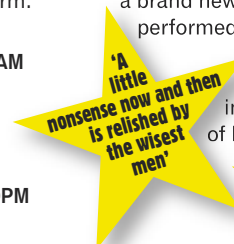

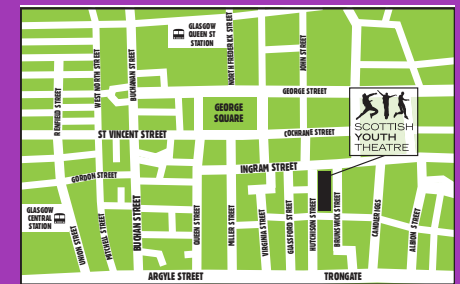
