S.1 TO S.3

★ Improvisational Skills Workshop (3hrs)

Descriptor: Using a phrase, prop, scenario or image as a starting point to show improvisational skills and learn how to improve them.

Curriculum level: Third

Experience: 'Having developed ideas from a range of stimuli, I can contribute to devising, rehearsing and presenting drama or scripts'.

★ Creating Character Workshop (3hrs)

Descriptor: In groups, create characters and devise scenarios on the Who, What, Where, Why and How of this person.

Curriculum level: Third

Experience: 'I can create, develop and sustain a realistic or stylised character through the use of voice, movement and language'.





S.4 TO S.6

★ **Creating Character Workshop (3hrs)**

Descriptor: Create a character and devise a short monologue to share with rest of class on the Who, What, Where, Why and How of this person.

Curriculum level: **Fourth**

Experience: 'In response to a variety of stimuli, I can use my understanding of characterisation to create characters using different approaches, making use of voice, movement and language. I can present my work to an audience'.

★ **Acting With Script Workshop (3hrs)**

Descriptor: Creatively explore **staging**, **characterisation** and **direction** to gain a fuller understanding of the text. The workshop will develop confidence in performing through physicality and voice to gain a fuller understanding of the language used and character motivations.

Curriculum level: **Fourth**

Experience: 'I can analyse technical aspects of drama and scripts, make informed judgements and express considered opinions on my own and others' work'.

★ **Technical Theatre Workshop (3hrs)**

Descriptor: The workshop can focus on Lighting design/ Set design/ Prop making.

Various technical theatre workshops are available at Scottish Youth Theatre @The Old Sheriff Court, Merchant City, Glasgow, or outreach if school resources allow.

Curriculum level: **Fourth**

Experience: 'I can use theatre arts technology to enhance tension, mood and atmosphere in drama work'.
