- Spaces can be **booked** by completing and signing the booking form and returning to Scottish Youth Theatre. All bookings are first come/ first served.
- All booking forms must be signed by parent or guardian (if participant is under 18 years of age). Forms can be accepted by post, fax , scanned and emailed or in person.
- Spaces can be **reserved** by telephone. However please note that a booking form along with payment is required as soon as possible to secure this place.
- **Payment** – classes can be paid either in full , two equal installments , or weekly. Fees can be accepted in cash, cheque or by credit/ debit card. If you wish to discuss other payment options please contact us on 0141 552 3988.

**DRAMA CLASSES AT HIS MAJESTY'S THEATRE**

- Weekly drama classes take place on Saturdays at His Majesty's Theatre, Rosemount Viaduct, Aberdeen.
- Classes are open to anyone aged between 6 and 25 years.
- Participants are taught by professional, experienced tutors with a passion for theatre and an expertise that is second to none.

## CLASSES

### 6 – 8 year olds

Sat @ 10 am – 11.30am

This class provides an introduction to drama through games and stories. Members are encouraged to develop their self expression and to explore their imaginations. Activities place emphasis on improvisation, including movement, character and story. The 6-8 class is an hour and a half long.

### 9 – 12 year olds

Sat @ 11.45am – 1.45pm

SYT 9-12 uses tutor led improvisation and drama games to help participants develop skills in acting such as character narrative development, voice and movement. Participant input is very important and much of each groups work will be inspired by issues of relevance to the participants. Most people find that SYT 9-12 is a great place to meet new friends with similar interests. The 9-12 class runs for two hours.

### 13-14 year olds

Sat @ 2 pm – 4pm

SYT 13-14 uses tutor led improvisation and drama games to help participants develop skills in acting such as character narrative development, voice and movement. Participant input is very important and much of each groups work will be inspired by issues of relevance to the participants. Most people find that SYT 13-14 is a great place to meet new friends with similar interests. The 13-14 class runs for two hours.

### 15-25

Sat @ 4pm – 6pm

The Senior Workshop concentrates on improvisation and provides a wide ranging dramatic experience. It is open to anyone regardless of previous experience. The 15-25 class runs for two hours.
